Norris is a conventional height, early maturing, winter hardy, Clearfield[®] Hard Red Winter wheat that is tolerant to imazamox with superior yield. The Clearfield[®] Production System for wheat helps growers to reduce severity of several hard to control weeds, including jointed goat grass, Persian darnel, feral rye, wild oats, downy brome, and many other grassy and broadleaf weeds.

MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

Minnesota / North Dakota / South Dakota

1. Plant **Certified** seed 1-2 inches below the soil surface.
2. Plant at a rate of 1,200,000 – 1,800,000 live plants per acre depending on planting date.
3. To maximize economic yields, apply adequate levels of nutrients based on soil fertility and yield goal recommendations. In general, 2.5 pounds of Nitrogen per bushel of expected yield should be applied.
4. Norris is moderately susceptible to leaf, stem, and stripe rust and is susceptible to Fusarium head blight (scab). Where rust or scab is a problem, Norris should be treated with fungicide at the 4-5 leaf stage and at flowering, following the manufacturers labels.
